Language Arts <i>Ms. Matthews - Rm. 7</i>	"Marble" composition notebook, one subject notebook & folder with pockets.
Math <i>Ms. Corbo - Rm. 5</i>	One single subject notebook, basic calculator with square roots (labeled with name), 100 page notebook, 2 colored folders with pockets
Science <i>Ms. Ahearn - Rm. 4</i>	Two single subject notebooks, folder with pockets, 2 packs of 3 X 5 file cards (any color), "marble" composition notebook,
Geography <i>Mr. Griffith - Rm. 13</i>	One regular sized, double subject notebook with holes punched, folder with pockets, 2" binder
Reading <i>Ms. McAuley - Rm. 6</i>	American Heritage dictionary, 3 packs of 3X5 file cards (white), at least 2" X 3" post it notes
Miscellaneous Materials:	
<u>Lock for your locker (combination locks are preferred)</u> , box of tissues and hand sanitizer, No. 2 pencils, pens (blue or black), red pen, colored pencils, metric ruler, glue stick and markers	
HELPFUL HINTS: Practice opening your lock, COLOR CODED folders for each class: L.A.- Blue, Science-Black, Math-Red, etc. Pens, pencils, markers, calculator, glue sticks, etc. may go in a pencil case that goes into a binder. One expandable 13-pocket file may be easier than buying separate folders for each subject. Students should use separate notebooks for each class. Extra items may be kept in lockers. Backpacks with wheels do not fit into lockers.
