With that in mind, we have provided a list of supplies needed for each class. Also, there are a few helpful suggestions enclosed that we have found to help the students over the years. We will assist the students with organizing their materials in homeroom on the first day; however, any assistance you can provide before then would be greatly appreciated! Please try to have these materials on Wednesday, September 9th so your child is not missing the help we will provide on the first day of school.

Language Arts <i>Mrs. Brooks- Rm. 10</i>	One subject notebook (10.5 X 8), 2 pens, 2 two pocket folders, glue stick, highlighter
Math <i>Ms. Ioanilli- Rm. 2</i>	One subject notebook (10.5 X 8), 2 pencils, 1 two-pocket folder
Science <i>Mr. Lenane- Rm. 11</i>	Marble composition book (lab work), 1 two-pocket folder, pen or pencil
Social Studies <i>Ms. Duffy- Rm. 8</i>	One inch binder, loose leaf paper, dividers, 1 two-pocket folder
Reading <i>Ms. Martland- Rm. 7</i>	Independent reading book, 1 two-pocket folder, pen or pencil
Miscellaneous Materials: A trapper keeper or 4 inch binder to keep all items except Social Studies. Two pencil cases with 3 holes in them (one for the Social Studies binder, and one for the other binder). One box of tissues for homeroom and bleach wipes for desks. Lock for locker (combination locks are preferred). Extra folder for notices brought back to homeroom. (May be used for art, music, etc) USEFUL MATERIALS: Highlighter, colored pencils/markers/pens, pencil sharpener, white out, erasers and small calculator.	
HELPFUL HINTS: Practice opening your lock, COLOR CODED folders for each class: L.A.-Blue, Science-Black, Math-Red, etc. Pens, pencils, markers, calculator, glue sticks, etc. may go in a pencil case that goes into a binder. Extra items may be kept in lockers. Backpacks with wheels do not fit into lockers.
